THE SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTIONS AND PARTICIPATION PROVIDED BY THESE BUSINESSES ALLOWED BLOCS TO BE ABLE TO AWARD OVER 11,000 CATHOLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS TO BERKS, BUCKS, CHESTER, DELAWARE, LEHIGH, LANCASTER, MONTGOMERY AND PHILADELPHIA COUNTIES FOR FAMILIES IN FINANCIAL NEED. IT IS THROUGH THE EITC, OSTC AND PRE-K PROGRAMS THAT BLOCS ARE ABLE TO ASSIST SO MANY FAMILIES.
